

HOW TO BECOME AN AGENT

If you would like to become a registered and authorized agent then we would ask you to follow the procedures as below:

The process to become an authorised ACP agent has some steps and ACP accepts the qualified genuine applicants by the agent.

Australian College of the Professions looks for applicants who has been demonstrating:

- 1. Proven at least 3 years of performance and activities in the Australian vocational and tertiary education and training industry
- 2. Provide minimum 2 referees from Australian registered training organisations including details of contact name, telephone, work name, position, history of the work and number of quality enrolments.
- 3. Present certified documents including PIER certificate (QEAC), ABN/ACN registered Certificate, Business profile, Company website, Marketing and recruitment materials, and staff details.
- 4. Present your work commitment and engagement with ACP.

Australian College of the Professions monitors authorized agents every six month for the performance and their activities. If they do not meet our requirement and standard of quality the agent agreement may terminate immediately.

Australian College of the Professions considers external factors such as the number of agents already operating in an original region and market.
